TRACK CLEANING By Jim Temple

Two of the least enjoyable model railroading activities are track ballasting and track cleaning. Ballasting is necessary for every realistic model railroad. The best thing about it is that when it's done, it's done. Track cleaning, on the other hand, is an ongoing chore that's necessary as long as you want your motive power to operate satisfactorily. Right?

There are different preferred methods such as running a track cleaning car with a dry rubbing block floating beneath it. We're all familiar with using a Bright Boy for stubborn spot cleaning. It's also important to clean wheels of your motive power with Goo Gone or kerosene. Don't put the engine back on the track without running the wheels clean on paper towel, if you're using Goo Gone. There are other effective methods you may have used.

Below are some techniques that you probably have never used.

For HO, try steel wool or a sanding block, gently, with medium grit sandpaper. For sure that sand paper will clean your railheads! You should probably use a shop vac to suck up sandpaper particles from around your switch points if you want them to close after cleaning, right?





Now for N scale, use a kitchen scrub pad or fine-grit sandpaper. Be careful to move the sanding block up and down the track, not across it, to prevent pulling track sideways off the roadbed. A small piece of brick could also be used. Kiln-fired brick is much better than those cement bricks, which crumble and leave lots of particles on your track, particles too big for N scale ballast!

For O or G scale track, the big stuff, you may again use the sanding block or a brick to rub, rub, and rub. Another choice tool would be a good wire brush. Again, you will want to suck up the particles from the track with your shop vac.



WARNING, DANGER, HAZMAT:

Before trying any of these track-cleaning techniques, PLEASE look at the date of this publication.... and don't be a FOOL!
