
## NCR Division 9 Meet Saturday January 18th Location is the Kalamazoo Bridge Club



In 2025 the Midwest Region (MWR) will elect a President, a Vice President, and three (3) Directors-at-Large to the Board of Directors. All the positions are for a term of two years, with two complete consecutive terms in office before a break in service is required.

The Board meets twice a year; on the first Saturday in April and the first Saturday in November. The meetings will begin at 10:00 a.m. (Central Time) and are about two hours in length. These meetings will be held via ZOOM.

Our main objectives are to provide events of value, items attendees will see as worth their money, all at the lowest possible cost. \*\* We will honor the traditions of past conventions but at lower cost and with greater flexibility. \*\* This convention will be shorter, starting at 1 PM on Monday and continuing through Saturday afternoon with a banquet Saturday evening. \*\* Note that registration includes all layout visits and operating sessions, and all activities at the hotel except Modeling with the Masters, and admittance to the National Train Show. \*\* We will support all the traditional activities of the SIG's. \*\* The National Contest will be fully supported. The contest will be in a prominent room and will be run by the National Contest team. There will be space for model displays, modular layouts and other functions. Those putting their models on display will have the option of entering the People's Choice Contest. \*\* We will have several prototype tours which may include a Ford plant tour and a cruise on the Detroit River with an emphasis on the industrial aspects of the waterfront. \*\* We expect to have at least 90 clinics. The clinics will be varied, and each will be given twice. \*\* We expect to have at least 60 layouts open for visit. Most layouts will be at least 900 sq. ft. in size running to over 3,000 sq. ft. in one or more cases. All layout visits and op sessions will be self-quided so you may take your time.
