# SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 17 RAILFAN THE WEST MICHIGAN RAILROAD 9:00AM CT/10 AM ET

Members of our Michiana Division will join members of the NCR Division 9 at the West Michigan Railroad (WMI) in Hartford, MI. The railroad uses locomotives from Great Lakes Locomotive (GLLX), and also stores many locomotives for GLLX. WMI currently operates about 4.23 miles between the CSX interchange in Hartford to 56th Street west of Lawrence, MI.

The WMI began operations in 1995, replacing the bankrupt **Kalamazoo**, **Lake Shore and Chicago Railroad** on an ex-**Pere Marquette Railway** line between Hartford and Paw Paw, Michigan. That company had taken over operations in 1987 from **CSX Transportation**. Traffic on the West Michigan Railroad consists of canola pellets, plastic pellets, frozen food, refrigerated fresh food, stone, methanol, and corn oil.


We are planning to meet in Hartford, MI. for a tour and presentation on the West Michigan Railroad. The presentation and tour will start at 10AM ET to look at the Transloading Facilities; the locomotive facility and where the WMI interchanges with CSX in Hartford.

NCR Division 9 will go for lunch after the tour and then meet for their annual division meeting. Michiana Division Members are welcome to join Division 9 members during lunch. The restaurant has not been picked out yet so look for the restaurant information a future FORM 19 Bulletin.



From Rich Mahaney, Division 9 member, NCR Director;

"On Friday June 3rd, I went past the Endeavor facility in Hamilton, MI and saw that a West Michigan Railroad engine is now located there. In the last two weeks the West Michigan Railroad has taken over switching that facility from CSX and now owns the track from Hamilton to Holland, MI. I was told that they would keep one of their engines at the facility to make the switching moves from Hamilton to Holland. Looks like they have created a new name for the line also the "Hamilton Northwestern". This engine is sitting right next to the fence gate that leads to the trestle over the river that is just north of the plant."

Construction: Display base of 1 X 3 framing with ½" plywood and MDF sheets of varying thicknesses

Track work: Cork roadbed with Atlas nickel code 83 flex track. Turnouts are Atlas #4. Structures: Combination of scratch build and kit bash. All structures are weathered with paints, stains and weathering powders.

Scratch built Surreys and Buckboards.

Scratch built structures include: Stockyard and office, Team track platform, Ore shed and platform, Track maintenance shelter, Depot and platform, Feed mill weigh office, Outhouse, Water tank and spring house structures, Windmills, Railroad trestle. Elevated Walkway Bridge, Power/telegraphy poles and wires, most vehicles.

# S-scale Automated Switching Layout at Indy Junction 2022 Conference

# Charles Malinowski demonstrated his automated layout at Indy Junction 2022, May 18-22.

Do you think that you don't have room for a layout? Do you want a switching layout to operate itself while you talk to visitors? This automated switching layout built by Charles Manlinowski shows you the way. It could be built in any scale. Charles' layout is built as two modules with a cassette switching lead at the top of the picture. An Iowa Scaled Engineering Motorman is mounted flat on the top of the layout hidden under the removable building in the lower left corner of the layout picture. The Motorman (\$99.00 including two opto sensors) provides the DCC power for the locomotive and the logic to throw the track switch so that the train goes back and forth, stopping at each end for its programmed time, and alternates which track it will operate on at the lower end of the layout.
